**SCHOOL SAFETY:** WES works very hard to keep your child safe. Our after school dismissal is one way to do this. The schedule of dismissal is as follows. Bus riders board the busses. When the busses are gone, we dismiss the students riding with parents that pull up in front of the building facing south. If for any reason you pull up across the street facing north, your child will not be dismissed until the vehicles in front of the building are gone. Then your child will be dismissed to cross the street with you. After all the vehicles are gone, we then dismiss the students walking home. We ask that you please leave the school immediately with your child so the walkers can then be dismissed. We also ask that you refrain from the use of your phone while in your vehicle waiting for your child, as we cannot dismiss the walkers until you have left the school. This is for the safety of the students, and we ask all parents who have others picking up their children to pass this information along to them also! Thank you!
